Re: North Idaho Vietnam Veterans Agent Orange Study.

Dear Veteran and Veteran family;

First, thank you for volunteering to participate in the Vietnam Veterans Agent Orange Study (“Study”). This has been a few years in the making, starting with my 2009 introduction to the Admiral E.R. Zumwalt, Jr. May 5, 1990 report on the “Association Between Adverse Health Effects and Exposure to Agent Orange” (the “Study”).

Following interviews with Dr. Robert Day (Director of the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Institute in Seattle, Washington) and Dr. Jeanne Stellman, PHD (Physical Chemistry), VST decided it was critically important to make sure the “Truth” was know about Agent Orange and what it has done to our Soldiers who served in the Vietnam War from 1961 through 1973.

The Admiral’s Study was a staggering condemnation of the VA, calling their conduct “. . .deceptive, fraudulent and shameful. . .” He further found that “. . . *the Bureau of the Budgets had ordered all the agencies of the government in essence not to find a correlation between Agent Orange and health affects stating that it would be most unfortunate for two reasons: A) the cost of supporting the veterans and B) the court liability to which corporations would be exposed.*”

The purpose of the attached Survey is to identify if and how Agent Orange has affected you and your family. This is a strictly volunteer program. But the data received will be processed through a special Exposure Program developed by one of the top independent scientists working on Agent Orange, providing you with a report on your exposure. In other words, ***tell the truth.***

Please complete the Survey and Consent form. In order to use your data and conduct the Exposure analysis we need the Consent form signed. It gives us the right to process the information you send and protects how we use your data. Also, please add your address at the bottom of the Consent form. When finished, deliver the completed Survey, Consent form and a copy of your **DD214** to VST. Please mail it to the address below. The fax number is: 208-773-9234.
